




Helene Response Appreciation

Log Cabin Award

Quilting has long been identified as an arts and crafts endeavor closely linked to mountain culture. Of necessity those who settled in these areas needed the warmth that a quilt provided, and they could be made from scraps and remnants of cloth. There was a functionality and economy to the craft that suited life on the frontier, while beauty and creativity were sewn into what remained of worn clothing and sewing scraps.

This design is the Log Cabin block. The center red square represents the hearth fire and the heart of the home. The block features an array of 'logs' or strips of fabric that build upon one another in a circular motion, similar to the way log cabins were once built. The strips are light on one side of the diagonal and dark on the opposite side signifying both the beauty and the challenges of life itself. The blue fabrics represent the beautiful hues of the Blue Ridge Mountains.

This quilt block has been crafted with love and given in sincere appreciation for the ways in which your congregation has responded to those affected by Hurricane Helene. In our darkest hour you have been bringing the light and helping many to rebuild the heart of their homes. Thank you for being the hands and feet of Christ to the Western North Carolina Conference of the United Methodist Church and making God's love real.
