In Preparation for Worship

On Sunday we will turn once again to the prophets. We've heard a lot from the prophets lately - all through Advent and now several weeks into the season after Epiphany. Prophets speak God's word to God's people. At times those words come as lament or correction. Other times as hope. But always words of grace.

This week we will hear from the prophet Micah 6:1-8. The passage begins with God pleading a case against God's people. God wants answers, "What have I done to you? In what have I wearied you? Answer me!" God wants to know what has caused the people to turn away from God.

But they misunderstand and answer with offerings of ritual worship - burnt offerings and sacrifices. This is not what God requires. Rituals will not suffice.

So the prophet answers with God's truth:

"He has told you, O mortal, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice and to love kindness and to walk humbly with your God."

God requires more than ritual worship. What they do outside the walls of the sanctuary matters. Their day to day lives must reflect Who they worship. This is where they have missed the mark.

On Sunday we will reflect on the prophet's words and consider how our Sunday morning worship is reflected in our day to day lives. The message title is "What is Good." I look forward to worshiping with you.


